We are now into our 16<sup>th</sup> year of supporting the older adults of the parish and still going strong thanks to the help of local donations from individuals, clubs, shops, churches, pubs and other organisations.

We must especially give thanks to Derbyshire County Council and our Parish Council for their continued grants however as besides giving welcome financial support these offer confidence to any other likely funding sources.

Our aim is to keep our members living independently in their own homes for as long as possible and in order to achieve this we open our Advice Centre every weekday morning and we have an answerphone system should members wish to leave messages.
