# A52 eastbound and westbound Raynesway to Stoney Lane: essential maintenance

At Highways England, we believe in a connected country, and our network makes these connections happen. In the East Midlands, we strive to improve our major roads and motorways, to keep people moving today and better tomorrow.

I'm writing to let you know that we'll be carrying out essential carriageway maintenance work to the A52 eastbound and westbound carriageways, between the A5111 Raynesway and the M1 Junction 25. We'll resurface the carriageway and the slip roads, refresh road markings and renew road studs.

To minimise disruption to our customers, we'll work overnight while the road is less busy. This will also ensure that our road network is as free-flowing as possible during the day.

Once completed, all road users will benefit from improved road safety and a smoother carriageway.

#### When will the work take place?

Work is due to start **Monday 10 August 2020** and is scheduled for completion by **mid-September 2020.** We will be working overnight from **8pm to 6am Monday to Friday excluding Bank Holidays** for the following phases of work.

- A52 eastbound closed 10 August 2020 to 2 September 2020
- A52 westbound closed 2 September 2020 to 15 September 2020
- A5111 northbound closed 16 September to 22 September 2020

#### How will the work affect traffic?

To maintain a safe environment for our workforce and customers, we will need to close the A52 eastbound and westbound, along with the adjoining exit and entry slips, as detailed above. We may also need some occasional weekend closures. During the closures we'll put in place a diversion route which we've agreed with the Local Authority. The carriageways will remain open outside of our working hours.
