NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Erewash Borough Council in exercise of their powers under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 made an Order on 11 October 2021 the effect of which will be that on 14 November 2021 no person shall, except on the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle other than a vehicle connected with the emergency services to proceed in the following lengths of roads between the hours of 10.30 am and 11.30 am.

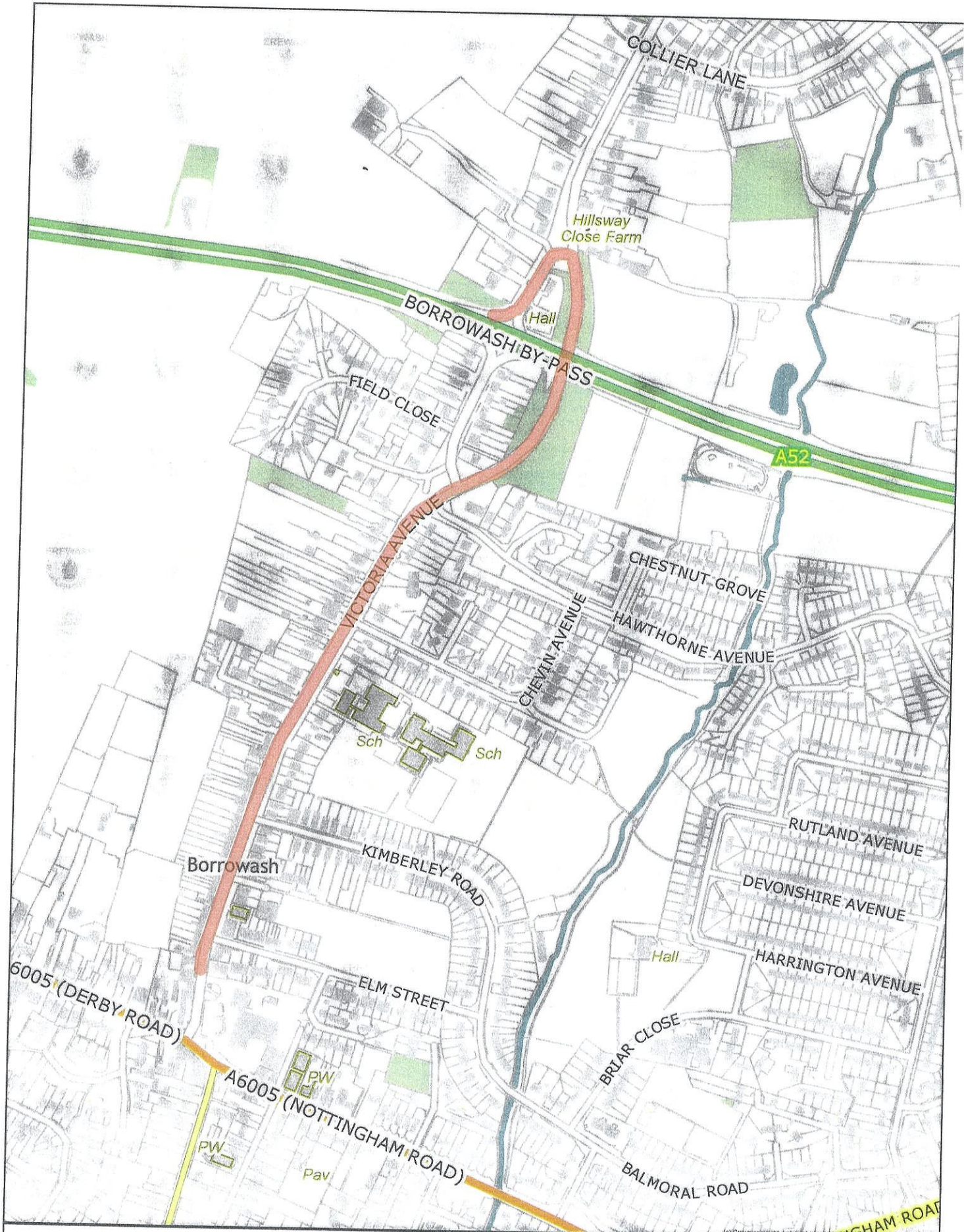
Lengths of roads in Ockbrook and Borrowash in the county of Derby closed between 10.30 am and 11.30 am
